- Junior (11-17) Helmets Required
- Young Adult (18 to 35) Helmets Encouraged
- Adult (36 to 65) Helmets Encouraged
- Vintage (66+) Helmets Encouraged

Event Details:

- Gates Open: 8:00 AM day of the event 8/9/25
- **Registration:** White tents (Pick up scorecard, maps, and info)
- Start Time Window: 9:00 AM 11:00 AM (11:00 AM cutoff must be on the trail)
- Rider/Equine Ratio: 1 rider per equine (no equines without a rider)
- Water: Horse water on the trail & at the reservoir. BYO drinking water.
- **Refreshments:** Free coffee and pastries Saturday morning. Bring your own lunch (food truck pending).
- Dogs: Well-behaved dogs on leash allowed in camp.
- NO dogs on the trail.

What to Bring:

- All Equine Supplies you think you might need.
- Snacks and drinks (plenty of drinking water for humans)
- Hay for your horse
- Rain gear

FAQs:

- **Ride Duration**: Fast (3 hrs), Average (4 hrs 30 min), Slow (5 hrs 40 min).
- Trail Marking: Pink ribbons, "Dad Jokes" on signs. Maps provided.
- **Weather:** Ride proceeds rain or shine. Be prepared for varied conditions.
- **Helmets:** Required for 18 and under, encouraged for all other riders.
- Refunds only if the event is canceled and not rescheduled.

Directions to Event Location - Top of The Grand Mesa Lands End Road/FS 100 X - FS 108

From I-70: (Grand Junction - Front Range)

- 1. Exit 49 (Grand Junction/Front Range)
- 2. HWY 65 South (Grand Mesa Scenic Byway) 30 miles
- 3. Through Mesa, past Powderhorn, up Grand Mesa.
- 4. RIGHT on Lands End Road (Forest Service Road 100)
- 5. 3.3 miles on Lands End Road.
- 6. HARD RIGHT on FS Road 108 (Carson Lake Road)
- 7. Look for big rigs ~1/10 mile off Lands End Road.

From HWY 50 (Delta):

- 1. EAST on HWY 92 3.8 miles
- 2. LEFT on HWY 65 (Cedaredge) 10.8 miles
- 3. Stay on HWY 65 at the traffic light.
- 4. Up Grand Mesa.
- 5. Lands End Road is 19.6 miles from the light.
- 6. LEFT on Lands End Road (Forest Service Road 100)
- 7. 3.3 miles on Lands End Road.
- 8. HARD RIGHT on FS Road 108 (Carson Lake Road)
- 9. Look for big rigs ~1/10 mile off Lands End Road.
